

Entry Requirements - There are no pre requisites for this course.

Language, literacy and numeracy requirements - This unit requires the ability to read and interpret a meter and then communicate the conclusions. Writing is required to the level of completing required workplace reports/forms, numeracy to read the instrument and interpret the results as being safe/not safe and so determine the required actions.

Duration - Typically this course is conducted over ½ day.

Delivery Location - This training can be conducted at either your premises or at our training centre. Where training is held onsite training rooms that can comfortably accommodate the class size are required.
