The Mine Site Safety Supervisor course covers safety management and legal responsibilities regarding OH&S and mining legislation. It will teach you how to isolate and minimise risk at your work site, investigate incidents and their causes, knowledge of the factors for effective oral communication site conventions and requirements for written communications including report writing, meeting procedures and follow-up requirements, conducting a presentation and basic negotiating techniques and their application.

This training is required for all personnel performing the duties of a supervisor within the mining industry in Queensland. Appropriate for those working in supervisory operational roles, or those functioning as members of committees or as safety and health representatives.

Entry Requirements - There are no prerequisites for this course.

Language, literacy and numeracy requirements - Sufficient language skills to be able to communicate with others in a clear and concise manner. Enough literacy skills to be able to read and comply with work instructions and specifications and writing skills to be able to complete written reports.

Duration - Typically this course is conducted in over three days.
