

## PUAFIR204B – RESPOND TO WILDFIRE

This training covers the competency required to respond to a wildfire, work as a safe and situationally-aware member of a crew to attack and extinguish a fire, participate in mop-up and patrol operations, and prepare equipment for the next crew.



You will learn about:

- communication on the fireground
- extinguishing media, water, foam, suppressants
- fire behaviour (fuel, weather and topography)
- health and fitness requirements
- hygiene and wellbeing
- organisational operating procedures
- safe work practices
- wildfire control tactics and techniques
- wildfire hazards, safety techniques

**Entry Requirements** - PUAFIR215 Prevent Injury.

**Duration** - Typically this course is conducted over 3 – 4 days. This does include delivery of the prerequisite (if necessary).

**Delivery Location** - This training is conducted at on site. Access is required to controlled or contained fires and firefighting equipment and extinguishing media as well as training rooms that can comfortably accommodate the class size are required.

**Assessment** - The assessment will consist of written and practical activities and written and practical assessment.
