

RIIHAN305D – OPERATE A GANTRY OR OVERHEAD CRANE

This unit describes a participant's skills and knowledge required to operate a gantry or overhead crane in the Resources and Infrastructure Industries. It includes:

- Planning and preparing for gantry/overhead crane operations
- Operating gantry/overhead crane
- Performing gantry/overhead crane maintenance.



This unit is appropriate for those working in operational roles.

You will learn about:

- accessing and applying the National Standard for High Risk Work
- identifying crane equipment characteristics, technical capabilities and limitations
- accessing, interpreting and applying technical crane information
- applying fault finding techniques
- identifying, interpreting and using hand and whistle signals

Entry Requirements - There are no pre requisites for this course.

Language, literacy and numeracy requirements - This unit requires the ability to read and interpret policies and procedures. Writing is required to the level of completing required fault reports and maintenance records, numeracy to for calculation of volume and weights.
