

RIIWHS202D – ENTER AND WORK IN CONFINED SPACES

This unit covers the entering and working in confined spaces in resources and infrastructure industries. It includes:

- Planning and preparing for entry of confined spaces
- Entry and working in confined spaces and
- Exiting confined spaces and cleaning up.



You will learn about:

- identifying areas that constitute confined spaces
- complying with site and equipment safety requirements
- complying with the entry and exit procedures, risks and regulations
- types of air contaminants and toxic gases
- identifying the limitations of breathing apparatus
- identifying equipment types, characteristics, technical capabilities and limitations
- complying with site isolation and site control responsibilities and authorities
- locations of safety data sheets (SDS) information and application
- using confined space and Industry terminology

This unit is appropriate for those working in confined spaces (enclosed or partially enclosed) for the purpose of carrying out work or inspections and also is appropriate for those performing sentry or stand-by person roles.
